Our recommendation for basic care:

Regular Dental Examinations

Routine dental assessments are invaluable as a preventative measure for the long term. We can assess changes in your bite, the dentistry in your mouth and the health of all the oral tissues. Early detection of any problems can prevent extensive future work. We recommend at the very least an examination every year. Routine radiographs (x-rays) may be necessary to assess any changes. We also recommend that you see us immediately if you become aware of any problems in your mouth.

Regular Hygiene Appointments

Research has shown, and experts agree, that there is an association between periodontal diseases (irreversible gum disease) and other chronic inflammatory conditions, such as diabetes, cardiovascular disease and Alzheimer's disease. Treating inflammation (reversible gum disease) may not only help manage diseases of the mouth but also help with the management of other chronic inflammatory conditions.

Your dentist or hygiene therapist will be able to make recommendations that are specific to you. Generally we recommend patients to see the hygiene therapist for at least a one-hour appointment every 3-6 months. This is essential in the care of your teeth and gums and for any treatment in your mouth. Your Perfect Smile Studios hygienist and our oral care co-ordinators will also be able to assist you in developing a sound home regime in between appointments.

DENTAL DECAY



Tooth decay is the commonest dental problem that requires treatment. An understanding of the causes of dental decay and using preventative measures will help to prevent complex dentistry in the future.

What is the cause of dental decay?

There are millions of bacteria present in everyone's mouth. These bacteria use the sugar in food and drinks to produce ACID, which dissolves tooth surfaces. This creates "holes" or cavities.

What is the treatment for dental decay?

The dentist can help by using modern equipment for comfort and technical accuracy, high quality filling materials for longevity and advanced clinical techniques to repair the damage done to teeth. However there are things you can do to prevent decay:

- Regular clinical examination and routine X-rays are essential to detect and monitor decay.
- Maintain good oral hygiene. Patients who clean their teeth well (i.e. good tooth brushing and daily flossing) should have less decay because more of the plaque (containing bacteria) is removed.
- Reduce the frequency of sugar intake. It is important to avoid sugary food and drinks in between meals. Each time you have something to eat your mouth environment becomes acidic. Bacteria work best in this condition. They produce damaging acid that causes deterioration of the teeth. After eating, the mouth remains acidic for up to one hour. Sugary foods provide plenty of nutrients for the bacteria to cause greater damage. Therefore, the more often you eat something sweet, the more decay will occur. For example, a packet of polo mints eaten at regular intervals throughout the day can do far more damage than a bar of chocolate eaten all at once.
- A patient who is at risk from decay should use a fluoride mouthwash (e.g. by Colgate) regularly. Fluoride strengthens the tooth surface (enamel) and helps resist decay by inhibiting bacterial action.
- Sugar free chewing gum. Chewing sugar free gum following a sweet meal stimulates your saliva production, which is very neutralising to the acidic environment caused by eating sweet and other foods. The more saliva the quicker the inhibiting action for the bacteria, thus less dental decay.
- Avoid sugary food/drinks last thing at night. A cup of hot chocolate just before bed is not a good idea because whilst sleeping there is no saliva flow to neutralise the mouth and so the bacteria work on your teeth whilst you sleep.

GUM DISEASE

Gum disease is a common cause of tooth loss in adult patients. At the Prefect Smile Studios, our prime concern is for our patients to have a healthy mouth with an excellent standard of home care thus preventing gum disease.

Detection of Gum Disease

Gum problems are mostly painless, and patients are often not aware that gum disease is present. The main causes of gum disease are plaque and tartar deposits around the teeth and gums that harbour bacteria. Smoking and conditions such as diabetes are also linked to gum disease and can make the condition worse.

Careful gum assessment, radiographs (X-rays) and special gum measurements accurately show us how serious the problem is. We then formulate the appropriate treatment solutions that will help to combat the condition. We look at:

- Signs/severity of gum disease
- Levels of plaque/tartar present
- Amount of gum inflammation

Gum Treatment Involves:

- · Cleaning/scaling of tooth surfaces to remove plaque and tartar.
- · Advice on correct oral hygiene e.g. the use of dental floss and special micro brushes, mouthwashes/gels and correct toothbrushing techniques.
- · Reassessment and monitoring of progress in advanced cases.

The Hygiene Therapist

A hygiene therapist (as opposed to a hygienist) is qualified to carry out examinations, administer a local anaesthetic, take radiographs and perform simple dental treatments.

At our practice we are fortunate to have a team that includes a hygiene therapist. After careful assessment by your dentist, the hygiene therapist carries out all the treatment necessary to ensure a healthy mouth, with sessions normally lasting an hour. Patients' needs can vary from one session of thorough scaling and polishing of teeth through to multiple visits when deep cleaning under anaesthetic is needed. We will advise you on how often you will need to see the hygiene therapist.



Laser Gum Treatment

Using a state-of-the-art dental laser machine, we can recontour gums for a more attractive smile. Lasers can also correct difficult gum problems in advanced cases without the need for surgery.

The Periodontist

For resistant gum pockets and more advanced gum disease, we recommend an opinion with our specialist periodontist. You will be advised on the appropriate need for more advanced gum treatment. Failure to have the required and necessary treatment will result in teeth becoming looser and eventual loss.

EROSION OF TEETH

A relatively new problem is becoming apparent in dentistry. This is 'wear' of teeth due to chemical erosion. This often results in sensitivity of the necks of the teeth to cold and sweet things. Another common area of tooth surface damage is the inner surfaces of upper teeth in teenagers.

Chemical erosion is the result of acid softening the enamel. If the teeth are then brushed with abrasive toothpaste the problem is made worse. The result is that the "softened" enamel is often removed over time.

The main types of acid that are dangerous for your teeth are:

- Citric acid Lemons, grapefruit, oranges
- Lactic acid Yoghurt, fromage frais, cottage cheese
- Phosphoric acid Soft drinks, and diet soft drinks
- · Acetic acid Vinegar, salad dressing
- Malic acid Apples
- Oxalic acid Rhubarb

It must be remembered that fresh fruit juices are just as dangerous for teeth as fruit juice mixtures.


Why does this happen?

Many of these fruits and juices formerly were only available in season. With refrigeration they are now available all year round and are doing phenomenal damage to teeth. An exaggerated emphasis on 'healthy' juice diets has not helped.

PREVENTIVE MEASURES

- Limit the number of episodes when acidic foods or drinks are taken. Try to eat all your fruit at one time of the day.
- 2 DO NOT clean teeth after taking acidic foods or drinks.
- If possible, rinse your mouth with milk or a fluoride mouthwash after eating or drinking acidic foods.
- Drink fruit juices through a wide bore straw thus getting the acid past the teeth and away from the mouth.
- Try to avoid diet or fizzy drinks. If you have them, drink them through a wide bore straw or drink them very quickly to reduce acid contact time.

What is Oral (Mouth) Cancer?

Oral cancer is a generalised term for any type of cancer found in or near the mouth and throat. It includes cancers of the lips, gums, mouth, tongue, cheeks, palate, throat, oropharynx, vocal cords, piriform sinus, hypo pharynx and pharynx.

- Mouth (Oral) Cancer is responsible for 5 deaths every day in the UK
- Oral cancer can easily be prevented by regular screening with your dentist
- After treatment there is a 5 year survival rate which has hardly improved over the last few decades

What is involved in the Cancer Screening?

The assessment itself is completely non-invasive which means there is no pain. The dentist will use the relevant examination method to facilitate diagnosis and detection of anything that could potentially be abnormal. The examination and screening takes only a few minutes. Also, the results of the screening are given immediately.

- Visual Examination. The dentists will use their professional knowledge to help detect anything that is not normal.
- Advanced Fluorescence Technology.
 At The Perfect Smile Studios we use a technology called VELscope VX. It is a special device that allows the dentist to identify oral disease whilst it is still easy to treat. It makes use of a blue light that stimulates a natural fluorescence in oral tissues. This highlights disease not visible with the naked eye.
- Chemical Dye Detection. We use an advanced disease detection dye called Vizilight Plus. This uses another type of technology for oral cancer screening.

Does the examination hurt?

The examination is completely non-invasive and so there is absolutely no pain involved. The dentist will simply visually examine the oral tissues with and/or without the technology.

What happens if the dentist observes something abnormal?

If anything is detected that the dentist deems abnormal, you will be referred for a biopsy. This involves removing a small sample of the lesion and sent to laboratories for testing. On receiving the results of the test the clinician will diagnose your condition. On most occasions it should be non-cancerous. However, it allows for you to get treatment earlier to get you back to health again.

Your clinician will provide advice according to your diagnosis.

How Oral Cancer Screening helps

Oral cancer screening and examination of your mouth allows for early detection. This means you are more likely to have a better and improved prognosis in the unlikely event of a cancer diagnosis.




